You can use this form to enter the Edinburgh Marathon, Scottish Half Marathon, Hairy Haggis Team Relay, England Kilomathon or Scotland Kilomathon for charity. Please send this completed entry form direct to your charity as guaranteed charity entry is dependant on charity approval.

Each charity runner will be set a minimum fund-raising target by their chosen charity and they may ask for an initial donation to secure your place.

Your charity can then log on to our system and approval your place, once they are happy you agree to the fundraising target.

Kilomathon

The Kilomathon is a 26.2 Kilometre Road Race (pronounced Kil-om-athon) that is the perfect distance when training for a marathon or as a stepping stone from a half marathon.

The world's first Kilomathon takes place in England on **Sunday 14th March 2010** (six weeks before the London Marathon) running from Nottingham to Derby and takes in the picturesque Elvaston Castle Country Park.

The Scotland Kilomathon is planned to take place on **Sunday 3rd October 2010** starting and finishing in the Royal Highland Centre in Ingliston and going over the spectacular Forth Road Bridge.

Marathon, Half Marathon & Relay

The Edinburgh Marathon, Scottish Half Marathon and Team Relay will start in the city centre and finish at Musselburgh Racecourse. Race day is **Sunday 23rd May 2010**.

Marathon Shuttle Bus Services

We provide a shuttle bus service between the start and the finish of the marathon and half marathon. The runner ticket is a one-way service and is used by runners who want to return to the city centre after their race. The spectator ticket is a two-way ticket and is used by supporters who want to watch the start of the race and then travel to the finish. A runner ticket is £3.00 and a spectator ticket is £5.00. Tickets will be posted with your race pack. **Bus places are limited.**

Kilomathon England Shuttle Bus Services

We provide two shuttle bus services to get runners to the starting area before and after the race.

If you park near the finish area and wish to get to the start line before the race we provide an early pre-race shuttle service. Also, if you park near the start of the race and want to return to the start area after you have completed the race we provide a 'post-race' shuttle bus service. Tickets for the 'pre-race' and 'post-race' shuttle services are £5.00.

We also provide a one-way spectator service for those that wish to watch the start and the finish of the race. The bus will leave from near the starting area shortly after the race is underway. A 'spectator ticket' is £5.00. If the spectator wishes to return to the start area after the race they can purchase a 'post-race' shuttle bus ticket.

Edinburgh Marathon Team Relay

The Hairy Haggis Team Relay was introduced to give athletes of all abilities the chance to experience marathon fever without having to run the 26.2 miles individually. Teams of four run in consecutive legs, splitting the marathon distance between them. Please note that there is not a half marathon or Kilomathon team relay event.

Leg One - 8.1 Miles (The Royal Leg)

Leg Two - 5.4 Miles (Cock & Pan Leg)

Leg Three - 8.0 Miles (The Gosford Leg)

Leg Four - 4.7 Miles (The Glory Leg)

Team Members Details

You must enter the full details of all four members of your team or your entry will not be accepted. The team captain will have the opportunity to change the members of their team at a later date through 'My Details'. It is the team captain's responsibility to keep the team members up to date.

Team Categories

You must choose one of 7 different categories (listed overleaf) to compete in. There are prizes for each category and teams are limited to one prize. Young guns must have a combined age of less than or equal to 100 years, Auld Reekie teams must have a combined age of greater than or equal to 180 years. We do not count fractions of a year e.g. four runners aged 25 years and 11 months are eligible of the young guns challenge.

Team Relay Buses

Relay buses to get you to and from the changeover points are £20 per team and are sold on a first-come, first-served basis. **Bus places are limited.**
